



#### **Now In USA**

Under Obamacare (worse if Trumpcare)

- 27 million Uninsured,
   30 million Underinsured
- Large deductibles and co-pays (often % of bill)
- Limited "networks" out of network costs not covered
- Minimal strategic planning

And in all other wealthy nations

- Universal Insurance
- No deductibles and small co-pays, No %
- Free choice of doctor or hospital
- Planning by regional health boards







### Our High Costs Impede Our Care








More Americans die from easily treatable illnesses like asthma



### We are Less Healthy and We Die Younger




### We Have the Most Wasteful Health System




## Spending on Health Insurance Administration per Capita, 2012





### **America Spends More Than Double Most Other Modern Nations**




### Increasing healthcare costs are exploding the federal budget (Social Security much less so)



### Medicare for All is the Most Conservative Health Reform:

- 1. Cuts bureaucracy in half
- 2. The only sustainable reform proposal
- 3. Reduces Fraud (10% of all health costs)
- 4. Makes American business more competitive
- 5. Friedrich Hayek, Nobel Prize winning <u>conservative</u> economist: "for those common hazards of life" which individuals cannot prepare for, "the state should act." He advocates for government health insurance
- 6. Families are more independent with health care covered: less need for other government assistance (food stamps, housing, TANF..)

No wonder Conservative parties in <u>all</u> other free-market economies: Germany, Taiwan, Japan... strongly support universal healthcare



Single-Payer (socialized Insurance)

#### First - A Moral Reason!

- Health Care is a Human Right! Not a Commodity
- Universal: Everybody in, Nobody out! Cradle to Grave, Great health insurance for every American.

#### **Second- A Fiscal Reason!**

- One Insurance Entity: Supercharged Medicare For All
- Cuts nearly \$1 Trillion <u>each year</u> in Health Costs when fully implemented.
